



## Carlisle Barracks Disinterment Program

### Children Returned

- The Army continues to consult with Federally recognized Tribes to return children interred in the Carlisle Barracks Post Cemetery to their Families and Tribes. As of September 2024, the Army has returned a **total of 41 children**:
- **August 2017** – **Two** children returned to the Northern Arapaho Tribe and Families.
- **June 2018** - **Three** children returned to the Northern Arapaho Tribe, Blackfeet Nation, and Oglala Sioux Families.
- **June 2019** - **Six** children returned to Families and Tribes (Oneida Nation, Omaha Tribe, Modoc Tribe, and the Iowa Tribe).
- **2020** – COVID-19 prevented disinterments this year.
- **July 2021** – **Ten** returned to two Tribes; one Alaskan Aleut and nine Rosebud Sioux children returned to their Families and Village / Tribe.
- **July 2022** - **Seven** children returned to Families and Tribes (Oneida Nation, Washoe Tribe, Umpqua Tribe, Ute Tribe, and Alaskan Native Villages).
- **September 2023** – **Four** children returned to Families and Tribes (Sisseton Wahpeton Oyate Sioux, Spirit Lake Sioux, Blackfeet Nation, and Northern Arapaho Tribe).
- **September 2024** – **Nine** children returned to Families and Tribes (Oglala Sioux Tribe, Gros Ventre of the Fort Belknap Indian Community, Wichita Tribe, Eastern Shoshone and Seminole Nation of OK).
